In this first forum in the series, Consul General Okada will speak about the opening of the consulate in Vancouver in 1889 as Japan's first government office in Canada based on research of diplomatic documents from that time period. Keynote speakers Ann-Lee and Gordon Switzer will speak about the earliest contacts between Japanese and Canadians in B.C. and the establishment of the first Japanese communities in the province.

Following the speakers, there will be a panel discussion and a Q&A session open for public participation. Everyone welcome!
