Keynote speaker Greg Masuda will tell his story as a third-generation Japanese Canadian and focus on what it means to be Japanese Canadian after Redress. Consul General Okada will briefly highlight key historical events and talk about current Japan-Canada diplomatic relations: What are some important issues? What is the future outlook?
