Seeking a fresh start in life, Hinami (Karina) applies for a part-time job cutting sugarcane on a plantation in Okinawa belonging to Mr. and Mrs. Taira (Kitamura Saburo and Yoshida Taeko). She soon finds herself working with four other young men and women on a remote island under the supervision of the experienced Yutaka (Omori Nao). Their task is to harvest all 70,000 sugar cane plants by the end of March, but the demanding physical labor and Yuyaka's leadership soon cause problems. Despite the help of the Taira's former neighbor, doubts arise as to the ability of the conflict-ridden group to make the deadline, and hope seems lost completely when Yutaka is involved in a car accident.
